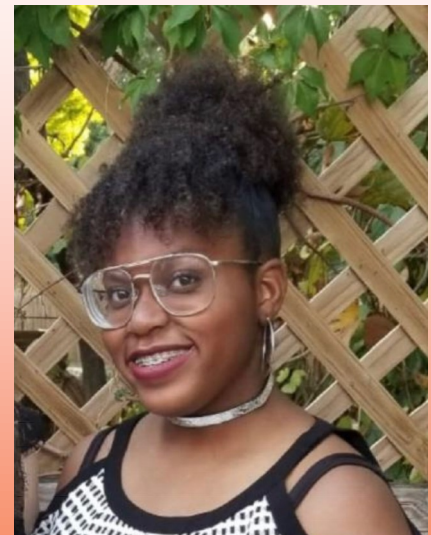
Youth in the Spotlight
